Membership in United Way of Larimer County's Alexis de Tocqueville Society is granted to philanthropic leaders who contribute \$10,000 or more annually through our organization. As a donor, you may choose to be recognized in national and local publications, or choose to be listed as an anonymous contributor. Through one annual commitment to the Alexis de Tocqueville Society you may contribute to United Way in addition to donating to the nonprofit organization(s) of your choosing. We facilitate your charitable giving for you and no administrative fees are deducted from your contribution.

Member Benefits:

- A United Way staff member dedicated to assist you in achieving charitable giving goals, offer donation consultation and provide feedback on how members' gifts are strengthening the community.
- Enrollment in the Give 10 Initiative which includes an invitation to the Give 10 Grand Gala.
- Opportunity to gather with like-minded individuals for social events and elegant members-only celebrations.
- Convenience! Gifts may be made through cash, credit card, payroll deduction, automatic bank withdrawal, direct bill or stock donations.
- Members are encouraged to designate at least 25% of their gift to United Way's Community Impact Fund. Other funds, such as the Child Care Fund, Bridging the Gap, Building Solid Foundations and the Legacy of Caring Endowment Fund are additional giving options to make a difference in our community.
- Members receive an email notification of account activity, a quarterly account summary through postal mail, and annual tax receipts at the end of January through postal mail.
- Members can make designations to all U.S. 501(c)(3) public charities, including churches, university foundations, and service organizations, for exclusively charitable purposes at the time they make their pledge/contribution to United Way. Please refer to United Way's Designation Policies and Guidelines for more information.
- Members who are not prepared to designate a charitable recipient at the time they make their pledge/contributions to United Way may establish a Philanthropy Fund at United Way to temporarily hold undesignated gifts for a limited time. Members and their designees can then make distribution recommendations throughout the year. To best serve individuals and families in need, amounts in a Philanthropy Fund must be distributed by June 30th of the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the amounts were contributed to the Philanthropy Fund.
