WHAT YOUR DOLLARS CAN DO

Based on an annual gift over 26 pay periods

\$7 per pay period can provide six nights in an **emergency homeless shelter** to help a local family find stable housing.

Why it matters: There are more than 13,000 families in Larimer County living in poverty. Additionally more than 20 percent of the homeless population is comprised of children under the age of 18.

\$25 per pay period can provide **quality child care and early education** at a reduced rate for low-income families so their children enter school ready to succeed.

Why it matters: 90 percent of the brain's growth occurs by age five. Quality early education is critically important to help kids get a strong start.

\$11 per pay period can provide **one-on-one after-school mentoring** for one local student to improve his grades.

Why it matters: 19 percent of Larimer County students don't graduate on time. One-on-one mentoring is a proven way for kids to stay on track to graduate.

\$50 per pay period can provide **job training** for three low-income adults to become self-sufficient and support their families.

Why it matters: 69 percent of people age 25 and older who live in poverty in Larimer County are employed at least part-time. Job training connects workers with employable skills that help them advance their careers and break the cycle of poverty.

\$21 per pay period can provide access to a **one-on-one literacy tutor** for a local child.

Why it matters: 76 percent of low-income third graders in Larimer County are not reading at grade level. Research shows that 74 percent of children who are behind at the end of third grade will never catch up to their peers.
