

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE APPLICATION



The Emergency Assistance Fund is designed to assist current WomenGive scholarship recipients in responding to unanticipated needs or unforeseen circumstances that cannot be addressed through alternative community resources. The funds are limited, and designed to be used for one-time unexpected needs, with the goal of helping a recipient remain in school and maintain family stability. Applications will be reviewed on a case by case basis, but all must meet the following basic criteria to have funding approved:

- Applicant must be a current WomenGive scholarship recipient.
- Applicant must have available funding. Maximum emergency assistance funding is \$400 per semester.
- Applicant must show that they have consulted with a community advisor to address the need and identify community resources. If applicant does not have an advisor, applicant must consult with WomenGive Navigator Joni Antonia, MSW.
- Application must be completed in its entirety, with supporting documentation attached. Examples of supporting documentation are a copy of the bill, or an estimate of a repair. You may be required to submit a copy of your budget.
